Chabad Hebrew School offers a creative environment in a warm Jewish setting. The classroom is organized to take advantage of a child's innate curiosity, stimulating active learning. The afternoon is scheduled with a variety of age-appropriate lessons/activities that give your child ample opportunities to learn, to explore and to grow in his or her knowledge and love for Judaism.
